

Yinnar Primary School's EASTER FAIR Friday 4th April



Dear Students and Parents,

Come and join in on the fun at our new and exciting Easter Bonnet Parade! This year we will be changing it up. In place of the egg launch morning students will parade their home made Easter Bonnets. We will also be running our egg decorating competition, and families are welcome to enter either one or both of these events. **When students are creating their bonnet, we are asking for each sibling to make their OWN. Families need to collaborate to create EGG DECORATING ENTRY, not an entry per child.** Please follow the below design brief closely as it must be adhered to.

BONNET CREATING CONTEST DESIGN BRIEF

- Must be hand made.
- Reflect the theme of Easter, incorporating symbols such as bunnies, chicks, and Easter eggs.
- Use a variety of colours to create a cheerful and lively look.
- Consider the use of texture in the design (e.g., fluffy cotton balls, fake grass, or fabric flowers).
- Decorations should be securely attached with glue to avoid them falling off during wear.
- The bonnets will be judged by staff members. The most creative/thoughtful design will be awarded a prize for each grade.

Due on Easter Fair Day (Friday 4th April)

EGG DECORATING DESIGN BRIEF

- Up to 3 **boiled** eggs can be decorated to make one scene/creation (backdrop). Only one creation per family.
- You must decorate the actual egg (not simply decorating wrappers), however you can add extra elements to your egg (e.g. hats, jackets, props etc.)
- This year the JSC will be judging the eggs based on these five categories: Most Unique, Most Detailed, Most Colourful, Easter Themed and Most Funny.

Due the day before Easter Fair (Thursday 3rd April)

Please deliver your decorated egg to the office with your family's name clearly labelled.

Families are welcome to enter both events, but please remember – bonnets are one per sibling and one egg decorating design per family.

For those families who are new to the school or need a refresher, here are some other details:

- We encourage all students to participate, it's a great **family activity**.
- All entrants receive a prize, and any designs that stand out to our judges will be awarded.
- Eggs for the egg decorating **must be boiled**.
- We do talk to the children about not wasting food and they understand that this is a once off event.
- The child/ren's **family name and grade(s) must be clearly labelled on the design**.

Later in the day, the JSC along with our other student leaders, run different activities at the Easter Fair for the students to enjoy. All profits of the day are donated to the **Royal Children's Hospital Good Friday Appeal**. Please see the note for new families for more information about this.

So come on – get creative, take a risk but most importantly **HAVE FUN** as a family whilst doing so!! The bonnet parade will take place at **9.00am on the day of our Easter Fair** in the stadium (the set up will be similar to the Book Week Parade). The 5 winning eggs from the egg decoration event will also be announced at this time. As always, the last day of the term is free dress. We always have a fantastic turn out of parents and siblings for the launch and you are extremely welcome again this year.
